



## Mahidol University Announcement

### Re: Flat-Rate Tuition Fees for Undergraduate Studies (International Programs) For Students with Identification Numbers 66xxxxx B.E. 2568 (A.D. 2025)

This is to ensure that the enrollment and tuition fee payment of Mahidol University undergraduate studies (International Programs) are appropriate.

By virtue of Clause 11 of Mahidol University Regulations on Administration of Budget and Finance B.E. 2551 (A.D.2008) and its amendment, and the resolution of the meetings of the Committee for Determining Rates of Collection and Allocation of Tuition Fees No. 1/2565 dated 30<sup>th</sup> September 2022, No. 3/2566 dated 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2023, dated 23<sup>th</sup> May 2023, dated 9<sup>th</sup> June 2023, No. 1/2567 dated 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023, No. 2/2568 dated 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025 the President hereby has issued the announcement as follows.

Rule 1 Mahidol University Announcement Re: Flat-Rate Tuition Fees for Undergraduate Studies (International Programs) for Students with Identification Numbers from 66xxxxx Onwards B.E. 2566 (2023) dated 7<sup>th</sup> December 2023 shall be abrogated.

Rule 2 In these regulation

“Tuition fees” means the tuition fees collected from undergraduate students enrolled in international programs at Mahidol University, except those in Mahidol University International College (MUIC).

8.1 Fee for maintaining student status (per semester) for students who Leave of Absence and have not registered for courses and paid for tuition fees	
8.2 Fee for returning student status (per semester)	2,000 baht
8.3 New ID card fee (per card)	250 baht
8.4 Fine for late registration (per time)	2,000 baht
8.5 Fee for issuing copies of documents, such as certificate of student status, transcript or grade report, and certificate of graduation etc. (per copy)	50 baht
8.6 Fee for issuing a digital transcript, such as certificate of student status, transcript or grade report, and certificate of graduation etc. (per copy)	100 baht
8.7 Fee for changing personal information, such as name-surname etc. (per time)	20 baht
8.8 Fee for issuing copies of other documents (per copy)	20 baht
8.9 Fee for diploma translation or a replacement of diploma (per copy)	100 baht
8.10 Bank transaction fees, students shall pay directly to the bank at the rate charged by the bank	
8.11 Fees for sending documents via registered mail (per time)	20 baht
8.12 Fees for sending documents via Express Mail Service (EMS) (per time)	50 baht

Rule 9: The student must request leave, and student status will not be maintained after having registered and paid tuition fees. Students who wish to cease their studies, resign their student status, or whose student status has been terminated cannot have their tuition fees refunded.

Rule 10 Students who maintain a debt with the university must fully settle their debt before the next Registration for courses. If they have received an approval for postponing such debt from the Vice President for Education, the debt must be fully settled within the semester which such postponement is approved.

This Announcement shall come into force now onwards.
